

Childhood Immunisation Coverage - Indigenous

The following tables provide the latest annualised quarterly report on childhood immunisation coverage for the **December 2014, March 2015, June 2015 & September 2015 assessment quarters** from the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR).

The data show the proportion of children fully immunised at age 12 months, 24 months and 60 months according to the Australian Standard Vaccination Schedule. A full description of the methodology used can be found in *Communicable Diseases Intelligence* 1998;22(3), 36-37.
